The FDA has released information concerning non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drugs (NSAID) for pets -- including Metacam, Deramaxx, Previcox and Rimadyl -- that shows they have been connected to 22,000 cases of illness in dogs, almost 3,000 of which were fatal!

Medical prescription

A prescription is a health-care program implemented by a physician or other qualified health care practitioner in

the form of instructions that govern the plan of care for an individual patient. The term often refers to a health care provider's written authorization for a patient to purchase a prescription drug from a pharmacist

Pharmaceutical Microbiology

In a series of experiments researchers grew yeast (*Candida* species) and bacteria (*Escherichia coli* and *Serratia marcescens*) into biofilms. They then exposed the biofilms to a promising probiotic mix identified in a previous study -- one part yeast, three parts bacteria, and a small amount of amylase (an enzyme found in saliva).
